

## **Sharpsburg Historical Commission Meeting 10/06/21**

- Discussion of display case options for Borough Building
  - Jocelyn provided vendor options for new cases and suggestions for other ways to obtain display cases/cabinets etc., including hiring a carpenter and purchasing secondhand
  - The consensus is to purchase secondhand
  - Members of the commission will investigate specific resources and places to be looking for secondhand curio cabinets, display cases, etc.
- Group reviewed drafted letter initiating the dialogue with the parish about listing St. Mary's (210 Garnier Street) in the National Register of Historic Place
  - Proposed edits were submitted by Joe
  - David will redraft the letter, send a copy to Joe for final review
  - Once approved, letter will be placed on official letterhead and mailed
